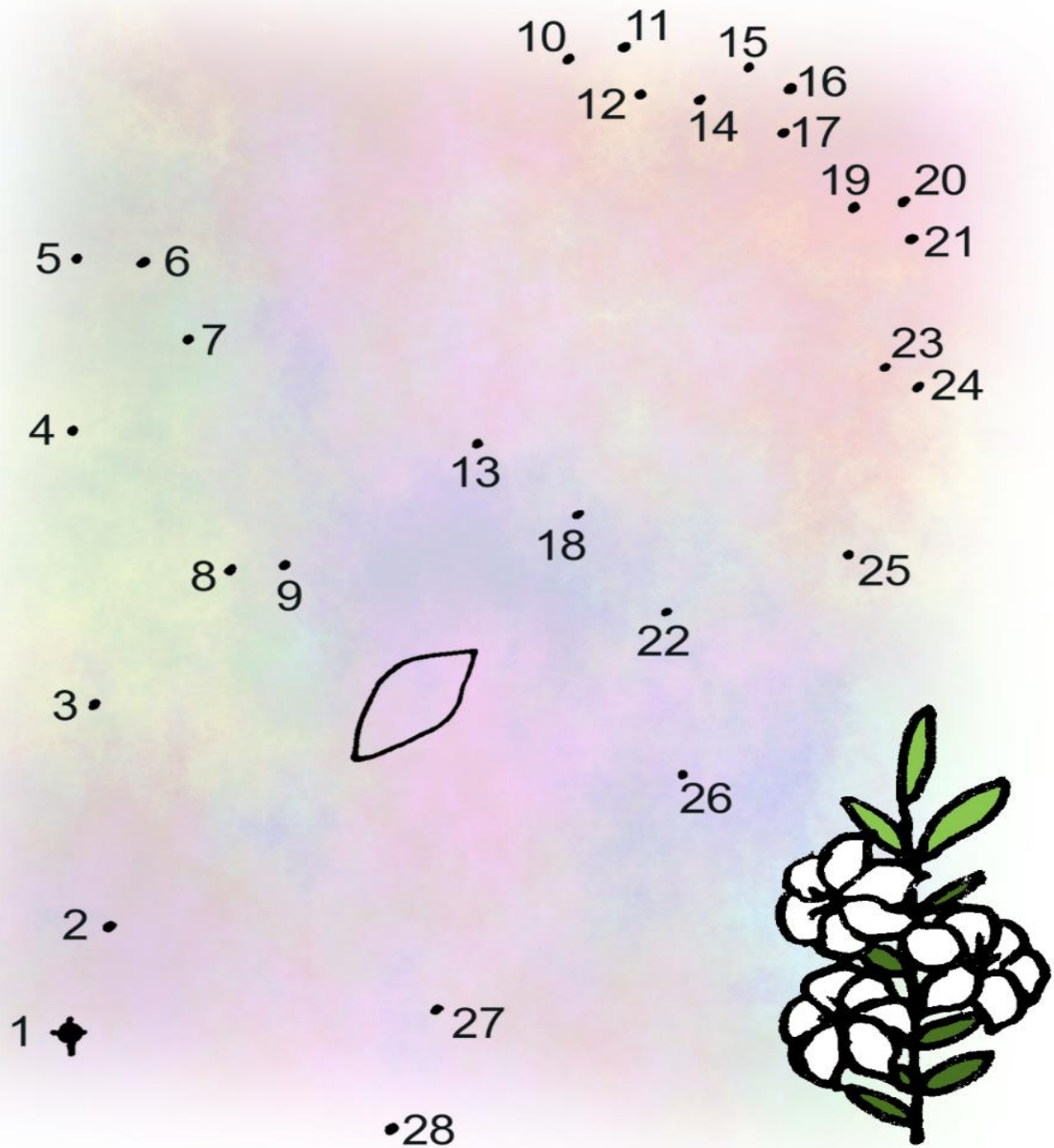

HERE ARE SOME CLUES IN CASE YOU NEED HELP!

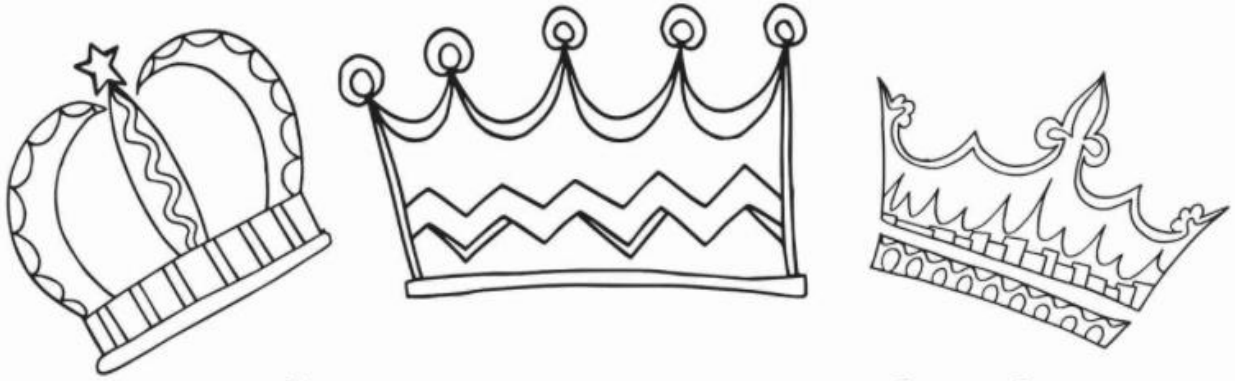
1. A pointed piece of metal used to hold Jesus to the cross. John 20:28(NIV)
